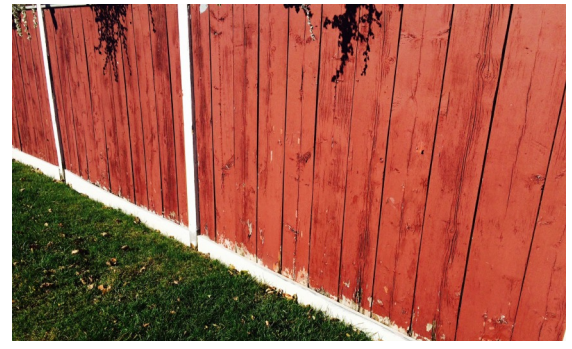
North Shore Arts Association 2016 Annual Appeal
