

NSAA Education Committee Report

2020 Annual Meeting

The Board of Trustees last year approved a broadening of the scholarship description allowing applicants to be eligible when heading off to college to major in “An art related field”.

Four applications were received this year for the NSAA \$1,000 scholarship. Two were from Rockport High School and two from Gloucester High School. Although the opportunity to apply for our scholarship was opened to Manchester Essex Regional High School this year, no applications were received from their students.

Two of the four received were eliminated due to their choice of majors. One will be studying Photography and one Film/Media.

The remaining two are majoring in Graphic Design, which fit into our description. One graduate is from Rockport High School and the other from Gloucester.

I felt, as did the Board of Trustees, that both grads are deserving and seem motivated to succeed. Upon my request, the Treasurer and Board of Trustees approved awarding two scholarships this year.
