



2021 New Artist Member Application Guidelines for Submission

Thank you for your interest in becoming an Artist Member of the North Shore Arts Association. The following information is to assist you with your application process for fine arts, painting, graphics and sculpture.

All work should be recent and of high quality. NSAA does not accept photography, painted over photographs, digital images, computer generated artwork, prints, giclee prints, copies or likenesses of another's painting, drawing or photograph, or what can be determined to be crafts or classroom work.

The jury process is anonymous. New Artist Members are selected solely on the merit of their work.

Application Fee: non-refundable \$45 due with submission of work. If selected as an Artist Member, your \$45 fee will be applied towards your 2022 dues.

1st Phase -

- Submissions of five (5) artworks in digital format September 12 - 16. *Late submissions will not be accepted.*
- Jury convenes September 22
- Notification of 1st phase acceptance by phone September 23

Image files must be jpeg format, 500kb (approx.) 300 dpi is recommended, cropped (no frame - image only). Sculptors must submit three (3) views. Your jpeg files must be named in the following format:

2nd Phase -

- Receiving of artworks September 24 - 26
- Jury convenes September 27
- Notification of newly juried Artist Members September 28
- Pick-up of non-accepted applicant works September 29 (10am-4pm)
 - Two-dimensional works: Five (5) actual works are required. Submissions must be appropriately framed, ready to hang and no saw-tooth hangers are accepted. Plexiglas is preferred for matted artwork 16" x 20" or larger, white or off-white mats are recommended. Minimum image size is 6 " 8"; works should not exceed 56" framed. Submission of actual works by sculptors is optional. All works should be labeled on the back with artist name, title, medium, size and price.

New Artist Members Show

- Two works will be selected by the jury to be exhibited in the New Artist Members Show October 2 -31.
- Final pick-up of all work is November 1 - 2

Artist Review: To assist the New Artist Member applicants who were not accepted, the jury will hold a group review of their artwork submissions. Applicants will be notified of the date/time for the critique after the application process.
